

Silicon Valley | 2018 Fees and Policies

Summer Enrichment and Camp Programs

DEPOSITS

A \$50 non-refundable deposit is required for each course. Deposit amounts will be deducted from the program fees. Please see *Program/Class Changes* below for our one-time complimentary deposit transfer policy.

PAYMENT OF TUITION BALANCES

The balance of fees for all summer programs is due by **May 13, 2018** via credit card only.

Note: Balance of fees for Economics is due March 29. Balance of fees for World History is due May 1.

COURSE FEES

Half Day: \$350/week (Morning/Afternoon) unless otherwise listed.

Note: \$70 discount for the week of July 2-6

Full Day: Tuition fees are as listed.

EARLY REGISTRATION DISCOUNT

Receive a 15% discount when you register for more than one course per student by 11:59 PM PST on March 4, 2018. (Note that the 15% discount is not applicable to the first course registered, but is applicable to each course registered thereafter). All courses need to be purchased in one transaction to be eligible for the 15% discount. Programs not eligible for this discount are marked with an asterisk.

REFUND POLICY

Beginning May 13, 2018 there will be **no tuition refunds or tuition transfers for any reason**. Deposits and program fees are **non-refundable** under any and all circumstances and cannot be transferred to another session or another student. This includes, but is not limited to, absence(s), withdrawal before the end of the program, and disruptive behavior or other misconduct. In the event that a course is cancelled due to low enrollment, full amount will be refunded (minus any credit card processing fees and registration fees associated with transactions). BASIS students enrolled in Pre-Algebra, Algebra I/ Geometry, or Algebra II/Geometry for-credit course may receive full refund (minus any credit card processing fees and registration fees associated with transactions) if student does not meet eligibility requirements to take the course (see your Dean for eligibility requirements). If ineligible, students may take Pre-Algebra, Algebra I/ Geometry, or Algebra II/Geometry for enrichment and will be refunded the price difference.

Note: For Economics, there will be no tuition refunds or tuition transfers for any reason beginning March 29, 2018. For World History, there will be no tuition refunds or tuition transfers for any reason beginning May 1, 2018.

PROGRAM/COURSE CHANGES

There will be one complimentary program/course change allowed after initial registration during which the \$50 deposit may be transferred without additional charge. Any additional changes thereafter will be processed with an extra \$25 charge to each transaction. No changes are permitted on or after the May 13, 2018 deadline.

EXTENDED SUPERVISION

Late Bird: Late Bird operates from 1:00 PM to 5:30 PM, and costs \$175 per week (\$140 for week of July 4). Drop-ins, hourly, and/or daily fees are not available. Registration and payment for Late Bird must be completed prior to using this service.

Late Pick-Up: The school closes at 5:30 PM. In accordance with our policy, there will be a late fee charged for students not picked up by 5:35 PM (\$15 plus \$1 for each additional minute). Late fee payment must be in the form of personal check or cash and is due at the time student is picked up. In the event that we are unable to contact a parent/guardian by 6:00 PM, the police will be notified.

Early Bird: Early Bird operates from 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM, and is free of charge.
